

Standing In Your New Transformation

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After an experience of such deep healing and freedom from previous areas of woundedness and bondage, you will likely feel a little ‘worn-out.’ This is normal – in fact your spiritual ‘recovery’ is akin to recovery from a surgical procedure in the hospital, so give yourself time to heal up! At the same time, you should note a new sense of freedom and victory in your life and the old ways the enemy used to ‘push your buttons and pull your chains’ have now either been greatly weakened or destroyed altogether. However, you must also be aware that your enemy has just lost a lot of ground, and what he “stole, killed and destroyed” (John 10:10) in you over the years has been in substantial part returned, resurrected and restored by Christ – and Satan doesn’t like that and won’t easily stand for it! Therefore, just as the healing and freedom you’ve gained were an exercise in spiritual warfare, your getting used to and standing in your new found freedom and healing will not come without some additional warfare, as he will attack you in various ways – typically to stress you with difficult setbacks, situations or people around you, threaten you that he’s not really gone yet or that the ministry session wasn’t successful after all – all to try and get you back into the lies and bondages he had you in for years or decades before.

Remember, if the devil can’t take your salvation away (his ultimate goal) by getting you to forsake God, then his next level of strategy is to make you ‘useless for Jesus,’ sometimes referred to as ‘castrated for Christ.’ That is not meant to be rude, it is meant to accurately describe the spiritual reality the devil is after in your life – to make you unable to reproduce spiritually, to make your life fruitless, useless, miserable, or make you happy about the wrong things in life. He wants to make sure you don’t connect with and live out your destiny – the reason God put you on planet earth in the first place. If you’re saved, to not live out your destiny would be your ultimate defeat since you were created and given life for a reason – to live out your destiny in Christ!

I would also strongly recommend that if you at all can, you should attend a **Strong In Spirit Seminar** if one is scheduled in your area, or contact Pastor Bruce and work with him to schedule one in your church or area. Transformation Ministry and the Strong In Spirit message are two very important sides of the same coin to help you really grow into the image of Christ in your life and become not only free, but also strong and powerful for Christ to live out your destiny! Also, while this time of ministry is all some people need, many people find that within a few months or so afterward, they’ve become aware of other areas of woundedness or bondage in their lives that they want to get free from, and request a short ‘tune-up’ sometime after your initial Transformation Ministry session. This is normal and is not necessarily in any way a sign of defeat or a failure – just more ground to take back from the enemy.

Finally, you might also consider writing down your Transformation Ministry experience on a paper or small brochure (see example of Pastor Bruce’s included here) to give out to others, I would strongly recommend it so others might be touched by God through this ministry. If you would like, we could also put your testimony on Pastor Bruce’s website – either with or without your name on it. Ask God if He wants you to do this as a witness to others of God’s freeing power worldwide.

How To Keep, Or Loose Your Freedom



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Keeping Your New Freedom

It's important to keep your freedom by following a few key recommendations...

1. Remember who you are in Christ.

The enemy doesn't want us to know who you are in Jesus. You need to begin exercising your will in a new way to make this truth your own. You are Jesus' child (Romans 8:14-17; 1 John 3:1-3; Galatians 4:5-7), set apart to become like Jesus (Romans 8:29) and called "My friend" by Him (John 15:15). Jesus Himself chose you (John 15:16) and empowers you (Luke 9:1). Use your authority in Christ (Luke 10:19). You have the same Holy Spirit who ministers to you, therefore you have the same authority. You are more than a conqueror through the blood of Jesus...

- † You are *redeemed* out of the hand of Satan (Psalm 107:2).
- † You are *cleansed* continually from all sins as you confess them to Him (1 John 1:7).
- † You are *justified* and made righteous through faith (Romans 5:9).
- † You are *sanctified*, made holy and set apart to God (Hebrews 13:1).
- † You are *free* from the fear of hell and death (Romans 8:2, Galatians 3:13).
- † You are *healed* of all sickness, disease (Isaiah 53:5) and guilt (Romans 8:1).
- † You are *forgiven* (Ephesians 1:7) and all your sins are forgotten (Isaiah 43:25).

2. Problems do not always end immediately after they have been prayed for.

James 4:7 says, "*Resist* the devil and he will flee from you." Use your authority to resist Satan when he returns to bring back old problems. Now that the demons – who tempt us and agitate us – are on the outside, it's easier to deal with them. Also, you know their tricks now.

Remember the saying, "Fool me once, shame on you. Fool me twice, shame on me." Demons often try to come back and claim their old territory. But if they are forbidden to, they can't.

Only you can open that door again to old demons, who come along with their friends (Luke 11:24-26). All of us are open to other demons – who may have the same function or assignment as the demons who were cast out – inhabiting us if we live in sin or allow other garbage to pile up inside of us without repentance. Sometimes demons work on us from the outside and fool us into thinking they are still on the inside. Speak to these demons with your authority in Christ. Don't give up. When the demons know you are convinced that you don't want them back, they will give up. Also, habits can be hard to break. Yet, without demons stirring you up, it should be easier to change your destructive patterns.

3. Avoid being demonized again by keeping yourself clean of all 'garbage.'

Demons do not enter into us the moment we sin or have some other kind of relational problem. It is only when we dwell on that sin or do not actively take steps to take care of hurts or wounds from relational breakdowns that we are open to infestation by demons. Remember, *what happens in you is more important than what happens to you*. Live in God's love and forgive everyone.

Wounds not dealt with become larger and deeper. They become doorways for demons, giving them rights to re-enter.

4. **Keep growing in Christ and be continually renewed in your spirit by God's Spirit (Romans 12:1-2).**

Replace the destructive mental tapes in your mind with positive messages (Philippians 4:8). Spend time alone with God, reading your Bible and praying. Develop intimacy with Him. Participate in worship and praise in church and with CD's or tapes at home. Don't neglect fellowship with the saints (Hebrews 10:25). And know these truths about the enemy...

† I know Satan is a bluff, a liar and a thief (John 8:44, 10:10).

† Satan has no place, no power and no unsettled claims against me (Romans 8:33-34).

† On the cross the battle was won and Satan was made a public display (Colossians 2:14-16).

† I have authority over all the powers of darkness and I fear nothing (Luke 10:19).

† I have the same power in me that raised Jesus from the dead (Romans 8:11).

† Jesus and His power are the same yesterday, today and forever (Hebrews 13:8).

† I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me (Philippians 4:13).

† I overcome the devil by the Blood of the Lamb and word of my testimony, and I don't love my life even to death (Revelation 12:11).

5. **Get involved in a small group fellowship if you're not already in one.**

Full healing usually requires encouragement from loving, mature Christians. Close interpersonal relationships with other Christians can help ward off most of what the enemy wants to bring to us. Sometimes follow-up sessions with the Transformation Ministry team are needed.

6. **Make the necessary changes.**

Deliverance is not a panacea. Repentance means living a different way, changing habits, attitudes, friends or whatever may be necessary to keep and build on the healing and freedom God has given you.

How To Lose Your New Freedom

1. Unforgiveness toward yourself, God or others.
2. Failing to keep our life filled up with God.
3. Not resisting the enemy.
4. Unbelief, or ignorance and lack of knowledge, not believing what God says in His Word is true.
5. Allowing personal, family or generational sins to infect you again.
6. Demanding to see miracles, signs and wonders on your timetable instead of pursuing God, righteousness and an obedient life before Him.
7. Expecting God to do things on your terms instead of His.
8. Not being honest and transparent with God or in ministry about what is afflicting you or going on in your life.
9. Flagrant or habitual sin without repentance or conviction.
10. Letting fear re-enter your heart and rule there.
11. Getting tired of the warfare and opposition and giving up, instead of walking it through.
12. Hating and not obeying instruction.
13. Past or continued involvement with occultism.

If this Transformation Ministry benefited you, why not learn how to help others? 2 Corinthians 1:4 tells us to comfort others with the comfort we have received. The word 'comfort' can also be translated as 'help.' Jesus commanded us to preach the gospel and to teach disciples to obey everything He commanded (Matthew 28:19-20). This includes driving out evil spirits and healing the sick (Matthew 10:1, 7-8). It is a commission for us all. What a privilege to see people brought to freedom and wholeness in Christ!

Learning To 'Tie Up' The Devil



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Overview

Paul said we don't wrestle against flesh and blood (people) in Ephesians 6:12. Prior to your new freedom, one of the main ways the devil would likely get you discouraged and useless for Jesus was by getting you fighting/being in conflict with people. Rational discussion about important things is fine, but people have many areas of bondage in their lives – both believers and non-believers – and so the devil will attempt to get you back into fighting *them* – instead of *him* and his works in their lives! The most direct way to fight the devil and his works is in prayer to 'bind' or tie up his demons and their work against you.

Jesus taught us how in Matthew 16:19 (*"I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven"*) and Matthew 18:18 (*"I tell you the truth, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven"*).

The only time Jesus uses the words, "the keys," (Matthew 16:19) is given in the context of spiritual warfare, where He promises His church will prevail in the spiritual battle against the "gates of hell," (kingdom of Satan). "The keys" not only fit well with "the gates (of hell)" metaphor, they also fit well with the phraseology of Matthew 12:29 in terms of using the keys to 'unlock' Satan's house, tie up his power and "loose" his captives. Indeed, the Greek word for "bind" is most often translated as "imprison" in the New Testament, hence the irony of the prison warden (Satan) being bound/imprisoned in his own compound and his prisoners being released and set free from his bondage over them. And significantly, the immediate context of both passages in Matthew includes the only two references anywhere in the gospel accounts where Jesus explicitly refers to "the church" (16:18; 18:17). Therefore, Matthew strongly links the keys of binding and loosing to the church's mission on earth.

Further illuminating this, although Jesus gives the command to "bind and loose" to Peter in Matthew 16:17-19 (the "you" is singular), in Matthew 18:18, the "you" is plural, and so Jesus gives "the keys" to all His disciples. Therefore by clear implication, this call of Christ to bind and loose is given to the whole church, not just a person or class of persons in the church such as its leadership.

- † As Frank and Ida Mae Hammond write in their book, *Pigs In The Parlor*, "The power to bind and loose in regard to Satan is described as 'the keys of the kingdom of heaven.'" The word for 'kingdom' is 'basileia,' which means 'to rule.' It is the promise of God's Word that those who inherit the kingdom of God will rule with Christ (Romans 5:17, Ephesians 2:6). He has promised that we shall reign, or rule in life (Genesis 1:26, Psalm 8:5-8, Hebrews 2:6-8). How could we do this apart from being able to bind the power of the devil and to loose that which he had already made captive? It is a matter of rising up in the power of the name of Jesus and telling the devil what he has to do!

'Whatever' To Bind?

Jesus used one little word in both Matthew 16 and 18 to indicate what is to be bound, "whatever," as in "whatever you bind..." Jesus doesn't restrict the activities of binding and loosing to a single act, instead He broadens the potential application to "whatever...", i.e., anything necessary in the spiritual war against Satan. The only limiting factor here is the fact that what is bound on earth must be bound in (by) heaven

first – signifying that what is bound and loosed must be in accordance with the will of God in heaven. So we can bind any work (sin, sickness, etc.) or agent (demon) of the devil, and thereby help restrict and shut down his activities and “destroy the works of the devil,” (1 John 3:8) in people’s lives and expand and extend the effective rule of the kingdom of God in people’s lives on earth.

While what I have now described I believe is the main thrust of the “keys of the kingdom” and what it means to “bind and loose,” there are some other possible meanings of “to bind and loose.” I include them here for your consideration.

- † First, according to Liberty Savard writing in *Shattering Your Strongholds* (lightly edited), “Binding yourself to the will of God and your mind to the mind of Christ helps you achieve godliness. We can bind and loose, tearing down the strongholds that give the enemy place in us or others. To stand in the gap for others, bind them to the truth and loose wrong patterns of thinking and beliefs from them so they can receive the truth. Loose and destroy the distortions and deceptions of the enemy. Pull them out of the fire and wrap (bind) them in truth by fighting for them in the spirit world. Bind the strong man and spiritually plunder his storehouse for them, taking back what he has taken from your loved one – every good thing they once held dear or have not yet recognized as theirs. You can bind them to the things of God, stabilizing and steadying them while their minds are freed to focus on what they’re hearing from the mind of Christ as the Holy Spirit woos them, drawing them to the Father. With prayers of loosing, you can undermine the strongholds in their old nature and undercut the enemy’s deceptions, hindrances, devices and influences he is trying to bring against them. You thus give those you pray for every possible advantage and assistance so they may be able to pick up the battle for themselves and take it to full victory.”

Contemporary Examples Of Binding & Loosing

While experience seems to demonstrate that binding demons and loosing their captives “doesn’t work every time” it’s done, the same conclusion based on experience could also be reached regarding prayer, faith, sacraments and ordinances, grace, law, evangelism, healing, etc., yet no one would recommend that we discontinue those biblical principles and practices. Let us not make the same mistake in our warfare of binding and loosing against the enemy. Just because binding demons and loosing their victims is exercised weakly at times, or absent other powerful disciplines such as fasting, etc. or done in words alone without real faith in the power of God given to us, or without broad participation and agreement in the body of Christ where needed, or for a variety of other reasons, does not in and of itself invalidate it’s biblical usage. There are probably a large variety of reasons that many things Jesus commanded us to do don’t seem “to work” as we would expect them to, or work as effectively as when Jesus Himself did them (since we don’t share His perfection).

The following are some of my own experiences with binding demons in people’s lives...

- † When we were putting a lady through Transformation Ministry, her husband who is a ‘bouncer’ on a school bus for elementary age school kids, took the techniques we used against demons and applied it to his bus of elementary aged school kids. He took authority over the demons and forbade them to speak through the students and shut them down and commanded them to be bound, and his bus went from a ‘normal nightmare’ of kids to quiet as a bug! Needless to say, the driver and later others came up and asked him what had happened to his bus.
- † I agreed with a lady over the phone taking authority over the demons in her husband so that he wouldn’t object to a friend of hers coming for Transformation Ministry. A few hours after she hung up with me on the phone, she was amazed to find that her husband was just fine with

whatever had to happen to get her friend up here, no opposition or problems whatsoever from him!

- † Recently a friend called me, exhausted by the elderly lady she's looking after who suddenly has turned from a nice, passive, docile Christian senior citizen into a swearing, cursing, oppositional, 'run out the door naked' type lady. I told her we needed to take authority over the demons in her and command them to shut up and quit stirring this lady up, and restore her to her former tranquil state. We did, and I talked with my friend a few days later, and she laughed and said the lady she's taking care of has been a dream since we took authority over her demons! Now, far from being oppositional with my friend, she now calls her "my best friend, I don't know what I'd do without her!"
- † A friend has been trying to get her dog to shut up and stop barking. He'd go on and on for hours, day or night non-stop. She's tried everything, but nothing worked. Then as we were seeking God about it, He told me, 'It's generational.' I asked her if her dog's mom or dad was a barker, and she said, "Oh yes, his dad barked himself hoarse." So we bound the barking demon generationally, threw it out, and the barking has been cut down by at least 75% since. But that was not the end of it. A week or so later, he started barking at night and one of the neighbors was woken up by it, and in a fit of anger, opened the window and cursed the dog (which had been done before many times). The next day, she bound in prayer all curses spoken against her dog (including the previous night's one) – and her dog has been largely de-barked ever since!
- † A friend emailed me complaining of his dad's continued craziness and spouting all kinds of junk at his wife. I recommended we bind the demons of alcohol, insanity and paranoia in him as an experiment and see what happens. My friend agreed and so we did. His dad calmed right down, no big outbursts anymore. A couple of months later I emailed my friend and suggested we stop binding the demons in his dad and see what happened. But to my surprise, he didn't want me to stop until after Easter came and went because he said his dad was always the worst at holidays. So I agreed to keep binding the demons. Easter came and went without any problem or eruptions, everything was calm!
- † My daughter Megan called me needing some prayer one day. I was led to take authority ('bind') the demons in her boss at work as well as others there and I asked God to give her a great shift at a job she doesn't particularly like. She called later and told me that she had one of the greatest shifts at work she's ever had – she got 10 different positive comments from customers she served, she got the best place to wait on instead of the worst place and she said her boss was kind toward her instead of riding her and being grumpy! What a difference shutting the demons down in them made.
- † A friend always suffered from deep post-partum depression. She recently delivered her 4th child, but before she did, I and a couple of friends bound the demons in her and forbade them to push her into the post-partum depression that's always plagued her. Not only did she not go into a depression after delivering her girl (the very first time that's happened), but her 2 year old son has not put up a fuss having a new sister (even if it's competition in the family), he's cool with her being there!
- † A friend told me recently about his work as a nurse with potentially violent, institutionalized people. He and another male nurse had to 'escort' a patient out of one building to another on campus, and my friend bound demons in the patient. The result was that the left side of the man he was holding onto was peaceful and calm, while the right side of the man who the other nurse was holding onto who hadn't bound the demons in the man was struggling and fighting with him all the way. My friend said it was a sight to behold!

Prayers For Binding & Loosing

I like what Rev. A.T. Robertson wrote in *Word Pictures In The New Testament*, “The more personal we make these great words (of binding and loosing) the nearer we come to the mind of Christ. The more ecclesiastical we make them the further we drift away from Him.” So I include some written prayers on binding and loosing that might be of benefit for you to use.

- † From *Shattering Your Strongholds*, by Liberty Savard (lightly edited). “In the name of Jesus Christ, I bind my body, soul and spirit to the will and purposes of God. I bind myself to the truth of God. I bind myself to an awareness of the power of the blood of Jesus working in my life every day. I bind my mind to the mind of Christ that I can have the thoughts, purposes and feelings of His heart in me. I bind my feet to the paths You have ordained for me to walk in that my steps will be strong and steady. I bind myself to the work of the cross with all of its mercy, truth, love, power, forgiveness and dying to self. In the name of Jesus Christ, I bind the strong man and I loose his hold on everything he has ever stolen from me. I rebuke his works and loose the power and effects of every deception, device and influence he wants to bring against me. Lord, I repent of having wrong attitudes and thoughts. I renounce them now and ask Your forgiveness. I loose every old, wrong pattern of thinking, attitude, idea, desire, belief, habit and behavior that may still be working in me. I tear down, crush, smash and destroy every stronghold I have erected to protect them. I bind myself to the attitudes and patterns of Jesus Christ. I bind myself to the overcoming behavior and spiritual desires that line up with the fruit of the Holy Spirit. Father, I loose any stronghold in my life protecting wrong feelings I have against anyone. Forgive me as I forgive those who have caused me pain, loss or grief. I loose any desire for retribution or redress. In the name of Jesus, I loose the power and the effects of any harsh or hard words (word curses) spoken about me, to me or by me. I loose any strongholds connected with them. I loose all generational bondages and their strongholds from myself. Thank You, Jesus, that You have promised whatsoever I bind and loose on earth will be bound and loosed in heaven.
- † Or, “In the Name above every name, Jesus Christ of Nazareth, I take authority over every spirit in and around (name) for it is written in Luke 10:19, ‘Behold, I give you authority over all the power of the enemy and nothing shall by any means harm you.’ I flatten your hierarchies and cut you off from every other spirit. I rebuke and bind you and forbid you to speak to (name) in the first person as if you spoke his own thoughts. I command you to loose his mind, will, and emotions. I curse and decree dead every lie and I stir up the truth within (name) I call you (name) to rise up strong to hear and do the word of Truth that you be not deceived by others or yourself. In Jesus’ name on behalf of (name) I bind all mind-blinding spirits and all spirits of doubt and unbelief in and around (name). I decree the lies you have planted in (name) dead and withered. Loose (name’s) mind, will, emotions, eyes, ears, and tongue. I claim their soul for the kingdom of God and call (name) out of darkness and into God’s light and truth. I ask the Holy Spirit to stir up the truth (name) has received and cause it to grow and be fruitful. May the eyes of (name’s) heart be enlightened that they may know by experience the hope of their calling in Christ Jesus. Amen.”

Daily Prayers



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Submission To God Prayer

Lord, I commit myself to You and the guidance of Your Holy Spirit. I submit to You all that I am, all my gifts and talents, and even the calling that You have on my life. I give it to You; I die to it all so that You might resurrect it again in me. I commit to You the ministry that You have given me to do. I desire always that it be Your ministry, not mine. Lord, I want to see only what You would have me see. I desire to hear only what You would have me hear and to sense only what You know it is time to reveal. I want to speak what You would have me speak, under Your direction and guidance. Make me sensitive that I might hear You clearly and use proper ingredients in timely ways. Make me worthy of Your people's trust. May Your Spirit lead this session and cause our prayers to be those of Your own heart. May my words and attitudes be as gentle or as firm as Yours. Teach me of Yourself so that I might adequately represent You to Your people. Keep me in Your love, and don't let me wander from You. Love Your people through me, O Lord and work Your freedom into their lives through me for Your glory.

Daily Prayer Covering

I pray this prayer in the power of the Holy Spirit and in the name of Jesus Christ. I bind and bring to no effect all division, discord, disunity, strife, anger, wrath, criticism, condemnation, pride, envy, jealousy, gossip, slander, complaining, lying, false teaching, false gifts, false manifestations, lying signs and wonders, poverty, fear of lack, fear, murmuring spirits, deceiving spirits and spirits of Antichrist. These are all bound in me, my family and church family.

I bind all curses that have been spoken against us. I bind the power of negative words, and I bind and render useless all prayers not inspired by the Holy Spirit.

I bless those who curse me and pray blessings on those who spitefully use me. I confess that I am a child of God, that I am the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus. I am God's property.
